



APPOINTED PERSON: LIFTING OPERATIONS



3-day course aimed at client's employees who have responsibilities for planning and managing lifting operations involving all types of cranes, either at their employer's premises or at 3rd-party premises. To successfully complete this course, delegates should be able to demonstrate a working understanding of cranes, lifting equipment and lifting operations.

At the end of the course delegates should be able to clearly demonstrate an understanding of the requirements for planning and managing lifting operations as required by the Lifting Equipment and Lifting Operations Regulations 1998, understand their personal responsibilities as set out in BS7121 Part 1:1989 and, establish, implement and monitor the effectiveness of the safe system of work for lifting operations.

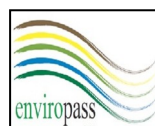
