CONFINED SPACE ENTRY INCLUDING ESCAPE SETS



A 1-day QualPass: TSAR certificated course covering the dangers associated with working within a confined space, what is defined as a confined space and safe working practices, culminating in written and practical assessment of delegates using our confined space vessel.

The course covers the theory and provide delegates with an understanding of potential dangers within confined spaces, together with those that could arise from work practices. Also covered within the course are safe working practices such as the contents of a confined space risk assessment, permit - to - work systems and environmental monitoring.

The practical element of the training involves the delegates entering our "medium risk" confined space vessel, together with tuition and discussion and familiarisation with confined space related equipment such as the access and rescue harness and tripod for top - down access along with familiarisation and the use of a multi-gas detector. In addition to the practical assessment, delegates must complete and pass a written assessment paper testing their knowledge and understanding of confined space work and dangers.

The course references with the HSE publication L101 Safe work in confined spaces: Confined Spaces Regulations 1997

The practical assessment session includes observation of delegates preparing themselves as part of a team to enter a confined space and to carry out the entry and exit as part of a structured safe system.



ESCAPE SETS

The practical assessment session includes observation of delegates donning a 10-minute emergency escape set within the confined space vessel under simulated emergency conditions using a non-toxic smoke generator.



This course does not cover the use of breathing apparatus or the search and rescue of injured persons within a confined space.

COURSE ASSESSMENT

Delegates complete an assessment paper prior to entering the confined space. On successful completion of the assessment paper delegates will then be observed by the instructor entering and moving around the confined space wearing escape BA.
