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LEVEL 2 AWARD IN EMERGENCY FIRST AID AT WORK



The Health and Safety (First Aid) Regulations 1981 require all employers to ensure that first aid provision is 'adequate and appropriate to the circumstances', and that first aid personnel receive formal requalification training every 3-years.

This interactive and practical based 1-day Highfield certificated course will equip Client's employees to administer emergency first aid to someone who is injured or becomes ill whilst at work. This qualification is only suitable for Clients operating in low hazard environments, or with a low number of employees present.

This course will involve the demonstration and learning of practical first aid skills; all delegates will be expected to demonstrate competence in those skills throughout the course. Delegates will be expected to work on the floor, therefore delegates are advised to wear appropriate and comfortable clothing and flat-heeled shoes; we recommend that female delegates wear trousers as opposed to skirts.

On successful completion of the 1-day Level 2 Award in Emergency First Aid at Work, delegates will be awarded a certificate and a wallet sized card both of which are valid for 3 years from the date of the examination. It is recommended that delegates attend an annual refresher course each year to ensure they remain aware of current practices in relation to CPR, etc.

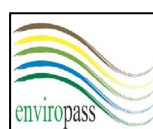
