CERTIFICATE IN CONSTRUCTION HEALTH & SAFETY - DISTANCE / E-LEARNING



The Distance Learning option has been developed to allow delegates, who through work or personal commitments cannot attend our taught sessions of this course. The NEBOSH National Certificate in Construction Health and Safety covers the main UK legal aspects of providing a safe working environment, the range of workplace hazards likely to be present in the UK construction industry, and the effective means of controlling these to prevent unsafe acts or conditions, accidents and incidents.

Delegates choosing this route will be provided with out full set of student notes, tailored to distance learning. At the end of each of the NGC1 and NCC1 unit elements are sample examination questions for delegates to attempt. Answers should be emailed to our Lead NEBOSH Tutor who will review the answers, and by return of email provide feedback and guidance on the delegate's answers. Delegates will receive replies within 5 working days of sending in their assignment.

Delegates are expected to commit up to 162 hours (equivalent to the 106 hours of taught delivery for this course and the required 56 hours of self-study).

Delegates will be responsible for contacting a NEBOSH approved centre to register for the NGC1 and NCC1 examinations, together with their submission of the NCC2 Practical Assessment 14 days after sitting the NGC 1 and 2 examinations

COURSE ASSESSMENT

Delegates will complete 16 assignments based in previous NEBOSH National Certificate in Construction Health and Safety examination questions which are submitted to our Lead NEBOSH Tutor for critique, including provision of a model answer. These assignments **do not** count towards a delegates examination results, and are intended to allow the delegate to measure their own understanding of the syllabus learning outcomes as they progress through each of the 17 units.

Delegates complete two 2-hour written examinations marked by NEBOSH, and a practical assignment within 14 days of sitting the written examinations which are marked by our NEBOSH Practical Assessor. The delegates final pass mark is based on the 2 written examinations and the practical assessment.

Delegates will be responsible for contacting a NEBOSH approved centre to register for the NGC1 and NCC1 examinations, together with their submission of the NCC2 Practical Assessment 14 days after sitting the NGC 1 and 2 examinations

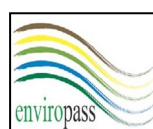
