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NEBOSH NATIONAL GENERAL CERTIFICATE IN OCCUPATIONAL HEALTH AND SAFETY DISTANCE/E-LEARNING



The Distance Learning option has been developed to allow delegates, who through work or personal commitments cannot attend our taught sessions of this course. The NEBOSH National General Certificate covers the main UK legal aspects of providing a safe working environment, the range of workplace hazards likely to be present and the effective means of controlling these to prevent unsafe acts or conditions, accidents and incidents.

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Accredited centre
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Successful candidates who pass the practical assessment and two written examinations can apply for Technician Member Status with the Institute of Occupational Safety and Health (TechIOSH) and Associate Member status with the International Institute for Risk and Safety Management (AIIRSM).

Delegates choosing this route will be provided with out full set of student notes, tailored to distance learning. At the end of each of the NGC1 and GC 2 unit elements are sample examination questions for delegates to attempt. Answers should be emailed to our Lead NEBOSH Tutor who is a Chartered Member of IOSH and a NEBOSH NGC 1 Examiner- email address is included in the pack - who will review the answers, and by return of email provide feedback and guidance on the delegate's answers. All replies will be within 5 working days of receipt from the delegate.

Delegates will be responsible for contacting a NEBOSH approved centre to register for the NGC1 and GC 2 examinations, together with their submission of the GC 3 Practical Assessment 14 days after sitting the GC 1 and GC 2 examinations.

Delegates studying outside of Pembrokeshire and who cannot reasonably travel down to our centre for the written examinations will need to arrange their NGC1 and GC2 written examinations with a NEBOSH approved centre who accept external candidates, as well as make arrangements with any such centre as to the submission and marking of their GC3 practical assessment.

COURSE ASSESSMENT

Delegates complete two 2-hour written examinations marked by NEBOSH and a practical assignment within 14 days of sitting the two written examinations which is marked by a NEBOSH approved practical assessor at the centre. The delegates final pass mark is based on the two written examinations and the practical assessment.

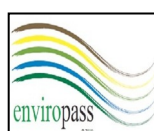
