TELESCOPIC HANDLER OPERATION



1 to 5-day (dependent upon delegates experience and competency and judgement of the tutor) QualPass TSAR course aimed at providing delegates with the knowledge and skills to safely operate telescopic handlers in their workplace. On completion of this course delegates will be able to competently prepare and set up the handler, prepare loads for lifting, transportation and lowering including the transfer and setting down of the load at its destination and shut down and secure the handler following use.

The course references into the Lifting Operations and Lifting Equipment Regulations 1998 and the Health and Safety Executive Approved Code of Practice L117: Rider-operated lift trucks: operator training.

1318 COURSE ASSESSMENT

Delegates will complete a mixture of theory classroom based sessions, together with practical use of a telescopic handler; to be awarded an operator passport, delegates will be required to complete a written assessment and a practical assessment involving the pre-use operator checks, raising, transportation and lowering of test loads under the observation of the tutor.

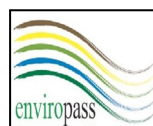
