FIRE SAFETY AWARENESS

The Regulatory Reform (Fire Safety) Order 2005 requires employers to provide employees with fire safety training. This ½-day course is aimed at all employees, particularly new starters in any workplace, where a basic understanding of fire safety is required.

Persons gaining this qualification will know that fire safety is the responsibility of everyone in the workplace with recognition of the contribution they may have to prevent the starting and spread of fires. On completion of the course delegates will be able to:

- Understand basic fire safety and what to do in the event of an emergency
- Understand the Principals of fire risk control
