SLINGER SIGNALLER



2-day QualPas TSAR course covering the safe working practices in relation to lifting operations, slinging loads with different types of lifting accessories and the recognised hand signals used between banksman and crane operators. This course is an ideal stepping stone for any delegate looking to become an appointed person – lifting operations as defined under the Lifting Operations and Lifting Equipment Regulations 1998.

Day 1 is theory based examining the legal requirements and safe working practices as set out in the Lifting Operations and Lifting Equipment Regulations 1998 and associated Approved Code of Practice, HSE Guidance Notes, etc.

Day 2 involves the delegates completing a written assessment and subject to passing the written assessment, they are then assessed setting out the area where the lifting task is to take place, slinging a test load and communicating with the crane operator through approved hand signals.

The course references into the Lifting Operations and Lifting Equipment Regulations 1998 and Health and Safety (Safety Signs and Signals) Regulations 1996.

COURSE ASSESSMENT

Delegates complete a written assessment and are observed by the course tutor slinging a load and signalling the crane operator during lifting, moving and lowering of a load.
