LEVEL 3 AWARD IN FIRST AID AT WORK



The Health and Safety (First Aid) Regulations 1981 require all employers to ensure that first aid provision is 'adequate and appropriate to the circumstances'. This interactive and practical based 3-day Highfield certificated course will equip Client's employees to administer first aid to a range of specific injuries and illnesses, and is suitable for Client's employees working within hazardous environments, or where the number of employees present is high.

Approved HABC Centre

This 3 day course will include topics covering: the roles and responsibilities of the First Aider; assessing an incident, recognising signs and symptoms of injury and illness, assisting a casualty who is suffering from major injury and illness, chest

injuries spinal injuries and anaphylaxis. During this course delegates will be expected to work on the floor, therefore delegates are advised to wear appropriate and comfortable clothing and flat-heeled shoes; we recommend that female delegates wear trousers as opposed to skirts.

On successful completion of the Level 3 Award, delegates will be awarded a certificate and a wallet sized card both of which are valid for 3 years from the date of the examination.

COURSE ASSESSMENT

The qualification is assessed via on-going oral and/or written questioning and practical demonstration.
